DAYTON (September 8, 2015) – On Wednesday, September 16, 2015 from 6:00-7:30 p.m. the Dayton Visual Arts Center will host its Annual Meeting during which Executive Director Eva Buttacavoli will discuss the Center’s economic impact on the region, present the Center’s accomplishments during the last fiscal year, and formally introduce the 2015-2016 Season Schedule and the exhibiting artists. 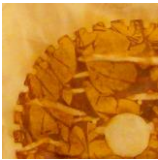
