# The Cline Show

## Annual Regional College and University Art & Design Student Exhibition

DAYTON (February 24, 2016) – The Dayton Visual Arts Center (DVAC) presents The Cline Show / Annual Art & Design Student Invitational, an annual exhibition featuring the work of 31 college and university art and design students from across the region. This show opens March 4<sup>th</sup> and runs through March 26<sup>th</sup>.

For The Cline Show program, students were nominated by faculty of fine art and design departments from Edison State Community College, the School of Advertising Art, Sinclair Community College, the University of Dayton and Wright State University. These students collaborate directly with DVAC, gaining valuable hands-on experience in exhibiting their work.

Each student is permitted to submit up to three works of art, ranging from painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture and design. Nominated students are also eligible to interview for the program's three mentorships, in which winners take on the roles of curator, preparatory and marketing and publication coordinator for the exhibition. DVAC provides specialized training to these artists through the process of organizing and participating in a professional gallery exhibition. This year's mentored students are:

In addition, in keeping with DVAC's commitment to building a community for artists, all participating student artists receive a scholarship to participate in Getting in the Game, a day-long artist "bootcamp" on March 12 at Rosewood Art Centre organized annual by DVAC, Rosewood, the Stein Galleries at WSU and K12 Gallery & Tejas.

This annual exhibition was named in memory of Barbara C. Cline who, in her 10 years as DVAC's office manager, positively affected hundreds of student interns and emerging artists. In that spirit, DVAC is proud to showcase college and university art and design students in this very special event sponsored by the Barbara C. Cline Memorial Fund, Exhibition Partners Amelia Hounshell & Brian Albrecht, and Education & Public Program Sponsors Beth Adelman, David Fogerty & Kathleen Watters, and Dr. Bob Brandt, Jr.

"DVAC was founded by Dayton-area artists, art supporters, and visual arts professionals who saw a need for more interaction between the public and regional artists. Working with our region's students, mentoring them and providing them with a true-to-life, professional gallery experience is at the core of what we do, helping to foster the next generation of artists and making connections to other artists and art lovers," said Eva Buttacavoli, executive director of DVAC.
