## DVAC ANNOUNCES THREE CALLS FOR ARTISTS

SUBMISSIONS OPEN FOR NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR ARTISTS

**DAYTON** (August 05, 2016) – The Dayton Visual Arts Center (DVAC) is opening the call for submissions for three upcoming opportunities for local and regional artists. These calls offer opportunities for inclusion in the Biennial Call for Major Shows, the Holiday Gift Gallery, and the 2017 CSA (Community Sponsored Art) program.

These opportunities are for emerging and established artists to gain exposure and experience through a formal showing at DVAC'S professional, contemporary, 1,800 sq. ft. downtown Dayton gallery. Artists 18 years of age and older are invited to apply now through DATE. There is no entry fee to participate for DVAC members and submissions will be accepted through the free online service CaFÉ (Call For Entry). Each of these three calls is juried by a qualified panel of artists and art professionals from throughout Dayton and the Midwest.

"Juried shows are extremely important because they reflect not just one voice, but a variety of voices and viewpoints from arts professionals across the Midwest and nationally," said Eva Buttacavoli, Executive Director of DVAC. "Running three calls simultaneously may seem ambitious, but having experienced art professionals hand-select works for presentation is a top priority of DVAC. Consistently presenting the best-of-the-best artists, vetted by experts in the field, is a priority for DVAC and it is how we connect to dots between the artist, the patron and the community."

The Biennial Call occurs every two years and is an open call for artist proposals for solo or group exhibitions for shows that will take place during the gallery's 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 seasons. Artists selected for the Biennial Call will be awarded a modest stipend, an illustrated color brochure with a critical essay, digital documentation of the installation and an opportunity to have their work travel to additional venues throughout Ohio. The Biennial Call submission is open via CaFÉ at <a href="callforentry.org">callforentry.org</a> and the deadline for online submissions is September 1, 2016 at midnight.

The Holiday Gift Gallery open call takes place annually and artists selected will have to opportunity to sell their works during 2016's ARTtoBUY, DVAC's annual "giftable" gallery. Submission is open via CaFÉ at callforentry.org and the deadline for online submissions is September 1, 2016 at midnight.

The 2nd annual CSA open call provides selected artists with a commission to create an edition of new work which will be offered to shareholders. Designed like Community Supported Agriculture programs, shareholders then receive fresh works of art in the summer. Submission is open via CaFÉ at <u>callforentry.org</u> and the deadline for online submissions is January.
